Nathalie Morin is without contact outside of Saudi Arabia since summer 2018

December 19th 2018 – At the beginning of the summer Nathalie Morin had warned her mother, Johanne Durocher, that she was prohibited to make any contacts outside of Saudi Arabia. Ever since there has been no news from Nathalie. On October 16th, Nathalie published a written message and video on her Facebook account that describes her situation. On October 27th, Nathalie Morin texted her mother that all her communications were being watched. She failed to respond to any of her mother’s messages subsequently.

“We don’t know if this order to cut contact with the outside world comes from her detainer, Saeed Al-Sharahni, or from the Saudi government. What is sure is that since this summer I haven’t been able to contact my daughter nor my four grandchildren”, states Johanne Durocher.

The Canadian government has tried to reach Nathalie through it’s embassy in Riyadh, unsuccessfully.

All communication with Nathalie has stopped. It is impossible to reach her and we have no reply to our attempts. We are concerned for her health, her safety and for her children. Considering the latest international incidents involving Saudi Arabia, we are worried for a Canadian citizen.

The Canadian government has spoken publicly in support of the release of Saudi women. While supporting this step, Nathalie Morin's Support Committee demands that it also acts for the release of its five captive citizens on Saudi soil.
