- Hadi Al-Mutif, a Saudi religious prisoner was arrested for his Shi'a Ismaili Muslim beliefs.
- He has been detained since 1993, making him the **longest-held religious prisoner** in the world today.
- Hadi is on death row because of his minority-status religious beliefs. **We want the King to release Hadi and be granted asylum into the U.S.**
